

ReadingKEY Weekly Test

INTRODUCTION: The ReadingKEY Weekly Test is an excellent tool to use as a final assessment on Friday to determine student mastery of the week's reading words. The results from these tests can be a valid part of a student's final reading grade at the end of the marking period. The test can also be used on Wednesday morning before beginning the new Wednesday and Thursday Grade 1 reading words.

DIRECTIONS: For numbers 1-5 below, call out the words in the left box in random order. Use Definition Clues for the words "red" and "men." Students are to look through the five words to locate the word and then write it in the correct space in the Box 1 column. For numbers 6-10, repeat the process with the words in the right box. Use Definition Clues for the words – "ten" and "yes." For more information on definition clues go to www.readingkey.com/definitionclues.

CORRECTIONS: Some of the best learning occurs when correcting mistakes! This is why you see a second blank space to the right of each row. After grading the tests, pass them back to students and have them correct their mistake in the "Corrections" column.
